For a direction to stop construction of recreation centre for BIWTA in the River Buriganga, at kamrangichar, P.S.-Kamrangichar, District-Dhaka, violating the provisions of law.

<u>AND</u> IN THE MATTER OF:

Judgment dated 25.06.2009 passed by the Hon'ble High Court Division in Writ Petition No. 3503 of 2009.

<u>GROUNDS-</u>

I. For that the duty and responsibility vested upon the respondents to serve the people and initiate lawful steps and they are also duty bound to obey the provisions of law. But the respondents have failed to perform the duties and responsibility as vested upon them and by way of violating the provision of law the earth filling is continuing in river Buriganga, which is illegal. Hence direction may be given upon the respondents to stop earth filling in the River Buriganga at Kamrangichar, Dhaka and to cancel the project in the Buriganga river.

II. For that disregard to laws and legal provisions and failure to ensure proper implementation of laws the respondents have caused enough damage to the environment and the city dwellers are adversely affecting to the right to life. Under these circumstances the respondents are legally bound to protect the river Buriganga in accordance with law.

III. For that under Section 5 of the **gnbNix wfWq kni I tRjvkntii tcŠ GjvKvn f tki nKj tcŠ GjvKvi tLjvi gV DbF ~ (b, D) ~ b Ges cKvZK Rjvavi msi¶b AvBb**, 2000, also prohibits change of the nature of any land that has been earmarked as a natural reservoir. As per section 8 of the Act 2000 any person who acts in contravention of the Act is liable to imprisonment not exceeding 5 years or a fine not exceeding Taka 50,000 or both. In spite of that provision of law and violating the directions of the Judgment the respondents are going to execute a project illegally in the river Buriganga at Kamrangichar, Dhaka. Hence a direction may be given to stop implementation the project in the name of recreation centre of BIWTA in river Buriganga and to cancel the project in the river.

IV. For that the non-implementation of the laws the respondents undermined the rule of law and frustrated the Judgment and directions given by the High Court Division in Writ Petition no. 3503 of 2009.

Wherefore, it is most humbly prayed that your Lordships would graciously be pleased to:-

A) Issue a Rule Nisi calling upon the Respondents to show cause as to why implementation of a project in the name of BIWTA recreation centre in the river Buriganga at Kamrangichar, Dhaka, should not be declared illegal and without lawful authority as it is violative of the provisions of law and Judgment passed on 25.06.2009 by the Hon'ble High Court Division in Writ Petition No. 3503 of 2009.

AND

Why a direction should not be given upon the respondents to remove all earth filling and structure building at Kamrangichar in the river Buriganga in the name of BIWTA recreation centre.

B) Pending hearing of the rule Direct the respondent no. 2-8 to maintain statuesque in respect of implementation of the project in river Buriganga at Kamrangichar, Dhaka.

Present Status

The case was filled and moved by Advocate Manzill Murshid, President, HRPB. After hearing the parties the Hon'ble Court issued Rule Nisi upon the respondents and granted ad-interim order. After hearing the parties the rule was made absolute.
